

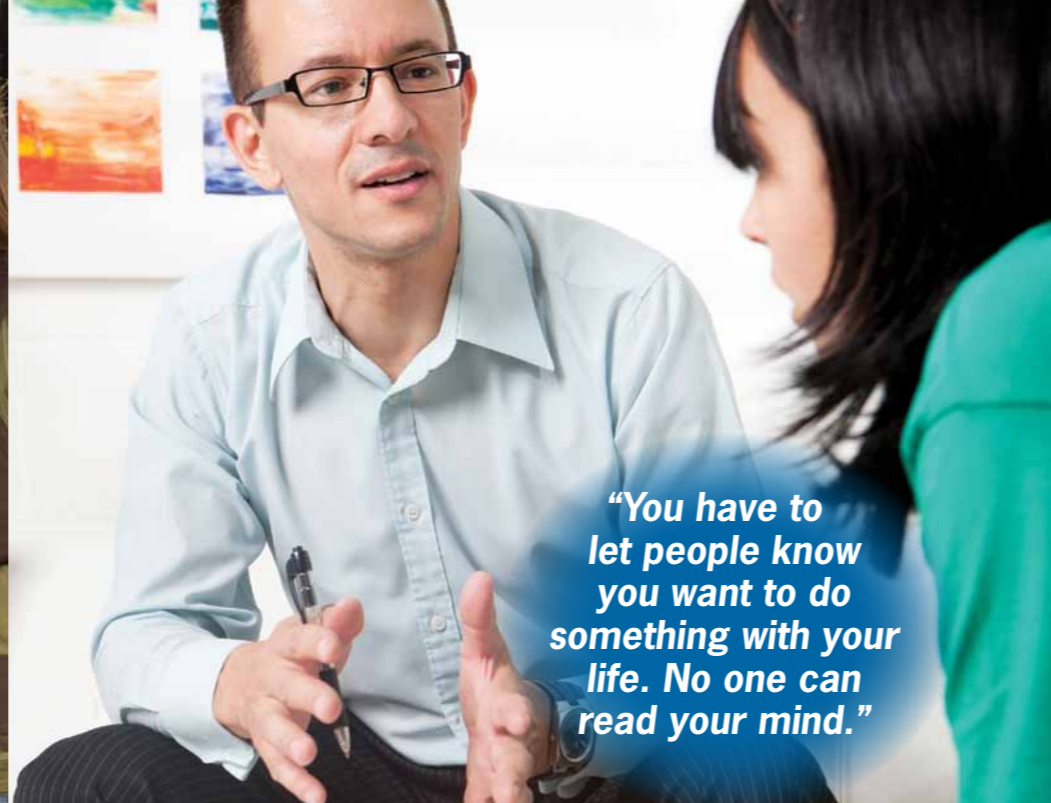

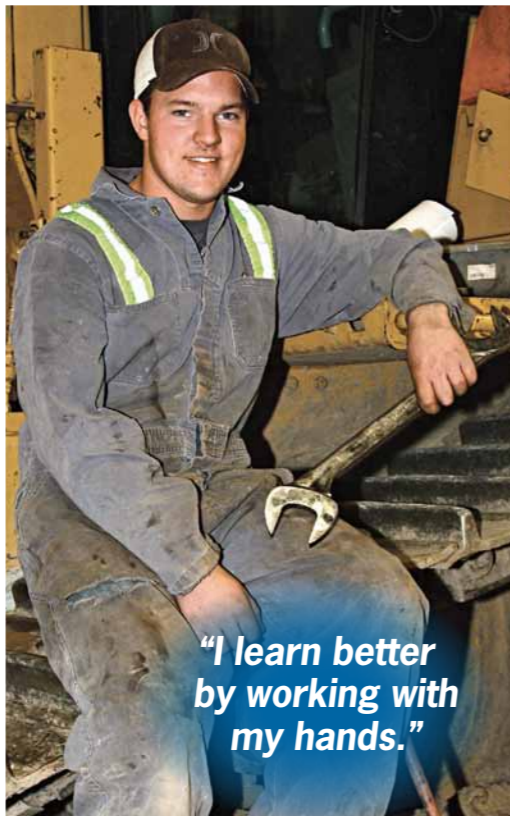

CREDITS AND CASH FOR YOUR PART-TIME JOB



Learn your trade by getting a part-time job as an apprentice. While you are earning and learning, you also receive credit for four secondary school courses.

“I can use the same trades training credits twice — first towards my graduation diploma and then towards my trades training certificate.”

CREDITS FOR A COLLEGE COURSE



Secondary school students can attend a trades training class, usually at a college. There is no tuition fee and you receive course credits towards your secondary school graduation.
